

We all headed off towards Canberra staying at the Pavillion Motel



went on a river Dinner Cruise. The food and venue was spectacular.



The following day we all jumped on a plane, flew to Broome where we were booked in to the Mangrove Motel



We were fortunate enough to be able to witness what is called The Stairway to the Moon, only happens on a full moon.



Rahim explains the complete procedure of fertilizing a cultured pearl and also explaining the complexity of the oyster.




Wendy had the pleasure of extracting this pearl from the oyster that Rahim was holding.
