NCRS Flight Judging:

NCRS judging is recognized around the world as THE STANDARD in determining originality. The judging system educates members about their cars in addition to providing recognition for excellence in the areas of restoration, performance, or preservation.

NCRS Concours Judging:

What if your Corvette is not completely stock? NCRS's newest award is for those that are not factory original. Even "restomods" with or without body modifications may be entered in the Concours classes where items are judged solely on their condition, not whether Chevrolet installed them during that model year. Points are earned at each event toward an NCRS Concours Award.
