We are in the process of the second stage of the Australian Mark of Excellence Award here in Melbourne this coming weekend. There are three cars entering for this Award. The third stage of this Award will be held in Sydney in 2011 at Rooty Hill.

We have a strong contingency in Perth and we will be holding another Mark of Excellence Award over there so they can participate in this Award.

The Chapter is in a very good financial position at the moment which is reflected in our Stock Report for 2010 and with our bank balance to follow.

There have been major changes to the NCRS Judges Manual this year. I will be working on bringing you up to date with our Newsletter and also with Judging Schools. The main areas they have concentrated on are the cracking down of counterfeiters. The ramifications are very severe, but the Board needed to take control of the situation by clarifying the difference between restoration and counterfeiting. This has all been laid out in the new Judges Manual.

There will be a road tour from Denver to Detroit. I will give more details as we get closer. Please consider coming along and enjoy the experience.
