





The NCRS WA attended the 51st Shannon's Classic Car Show, Ascot Racecourse on the 8th March 2020 to encourage membership for our club. There was a great deal of interest from the public and we gained possibly 3 new members.

This year there were a record 78 motoring clubs participating in the show - a record and well over 900 vehicles on display.

This year's special display was **'Past Cars of the Future'**, representing vehicles that were innovative and futuristic in their day. The earliest being an 1886 Benz Patent-Motorwagen through to the latest Tesla electric vehicles. Masterpieces such as the L78, 1965 Big Block Corvette, VW Beetle, Citroen Traction Avant and Jaguar E-type were displayed along with some of history's automotive curiosities such as a 1917 Rauch & Lang electric vehicle, 1930's Airflow DeSoto, a 1948 Tatra T600 and a Wankel rotary-powered Hercules W-2000 motorcycle; just a few of the vehicles that were ahead of a time that never came.



Peter Brock's Memorial

Peter Brock, dubbed "Peter Perfect" and "King of the Mountain" died on 8 September 2006, while driving in the Targa West '06 rally. Brock was 3 km from the finish of the second stage of the race at Gidgegannup, about 40 km from Perth, Western Australia when he skidded off a downhill left-hand bend on Clenton Road for over 50 metres in his 2001 Daytona Sportscar and hit a tree sideways, in the driver's door. The memorial is near the crash site and we stopped for a moment of reflection and a group photo before headed of along the gum tree shaded roads through the forest to the Mt Helena Tavern for lunch.
