

West Australian members gathered for the **NCRS Australia Inc. Annual General Meeting** on Saturday, November 30, at John's Factory, Marine Plant Systems Pty Ltd, in Cockburn Central. The meeting was accessible via ZOOM to the eastern states, allowing members to participate on a big screen in John's Boardroom.



The event was marked by a sense of community and engagement, with attendees discussing key updates and future directions for the organisation.





Following the formal proceedings, members enjoyed a delightful **sausage sizzle**, which provided a perfect opportunity for networking and camaraderie among participants.



This year's AGM successfully fostered a collaborative atmosphere, highlighting the importance of connection within the NCRS Australia Inc. community.

## Body Off Andrew's C3



Andrew has asked me if I would recondition the chassis on his 72. So, I thought I would take you along on this experience.

I decided to ask other Chapter Members if they were interested in helping with this project. It was great to see a good attendance on the day. Thank you to Joe, Anthony, Bill, Mick Andrew and myself.

The first thing to do was to get the car onto my 2-post hoist. We decided to have 2 teams, one team on the front, the other on the back, while I supervised the procedure.

I have done a body-on C3 but never a body-off, so it was quite interesting to see the differences between the C3 front section and the C2.



One of the major problems we had on the day was the setting the height of the car so we could all work on it. As you can see, it was too low for Andrew and too high for Bill. If Bill and I were just working on the car, we could have had it at a good height.





It was decided to remove the hood and remove the radiator and the associated brackets all in the one operation.

There is so much support equipment in the front of these C3's to support the longer body work.







The system I use with my 2-post hoist, is I made up this 150 x 50mm RHS and located 50mm steel pins through it, into the holes on the hoist frame to support the RHS. I then made sliders that can be poisoned anywhere on the RHS with a 12mm x 200mm Welded to them, I then have a 90 deg, by 60mm turnup. This then can make contact with the bottom of the birdcage, so we are lifting the whole car by the bird-cage.



The main problem we have is the amount of overhang on the front end which is unsupported once it is off the chassis. Bill said he had seen this system used before so we thought we would give it a go. Normally I would be putting the body onto my dolly, but in this case, we intend to leave it on the hoist. As I need to park one of my cars under the body.



With having so many pairs of eyes, while lifting the body off the chassis was awesome. That we could cover all areas at the same time, checking out if we had missed things that needed to be disconnected. Needless to say, there was one little earth-strap on the aerial, but it was soon picked up



We then moved the chassis from under the car and placed it on my scissor hoist where I could then work on totally dismantling the chassis and rebuilding it. The total time it took us from the start to this point, was 4hrs. which was a pretty good effort, that's all for now, the rebuilding of the chassis will be in part 2.


